## Chihuahas Rescued from Semi-Truck Accident Transferred to Multnomah County Shelter

All thirteen of the Chihuahas involved in Thursday's semi-truck crash on I-84 are on their way to the Multnomah County Animal Shelter. The dogs are all in good health, and will be safe and comfortable at the shelter while their owners recover in the hospital.

Five of the Chihuahas, a mother with three babies and a pregnant female, were brought to DoveLewis by an Oregon State Trooper. The remaining 8 were taken to a veterinary hospital in Troutdale.

DoveLewis salutes the efforts of the Oregon State Police and Multnomah County Animal Services to make sure these dogs quickly got the care and shelter they needed.
