DoveLewis Expands Emergency Services to the Oregon Coast

DoveLewis is excited to announce the expansion of its veterinary emergency and urgent care services to the Oregon Coast! After months of planning, DoveLewis will open its doors in Lincoln City March 11, 2010. "This is a labor of love we've been working on since last June," says Ron Morgan, DoveLewis CEO. "For years, people have asked us to open at the beach. I'm thrilled that DoveLewis is now able to serve other animal-loving communities by opening the first after-hours emergency animal hospital on the Oregon Coast."

Coastal residents and tourists aren't the only people excited about our expansion. Veterinarians between Waldport and Tillamook have welcomed us with open arms. "The central Oregon coastal community demands and deserves a centrally located after-hours animal emergency hospital. We feel that DoveLewis will benefit our community by providing this highly needed service," says Charles Hurty, DVM, owner of Grove Veterinary Clinic in Newport, OR. "During after-hour emergencies, DoveLewis can deliver the high standard of care to which our clients have grown accustomed."

Currently, in the event of an after-hours emergency, animal owners must rely on an on-call system that could end up sending them to a clinic many miles away, which could take too long when time is crucial. Dr. John Emerson, co-owner of the Lincoln City Animal Clinic, has responded to countless emergency calls late at night and on weekends. "This new service will bring expertise that will be a great benefit to the animals of the central coast and their human family members," says Emerson. "Dr. Hoffman and myself are absolutely thrilled to be a small part of this effort."

Fundraising is underway to help cover operational costs, and to bring some of DoveLewis' beloved community service programs to the coast. "We're thankful for a new partnership with the Lincoln County Animal Shelter which will help us provide emergency care for stray animals. Soon, we hope to offer a pet loss support group and offer financial assistance like we do in Portland," says Morgan.
