


DoveLewis FUNDRAISING TOOLKIT





Top 15 Items Ingested by Animals

"Dietary indiscretion" is the second largest issue treated at DoveLewis. Last year, animals ate more than 130 types of food, objects or other inappropriate items causing them illness or injury.

- Chocolate
- Human or animal medication
- Marijuana
- Grapes or raisins
- Chicken/meat bones

- Rat poison or pesticides
- Xylitol (artificial sweetener)
- String or ribbon
- Socks
- Plastic (toys, dishes, bags, etc.)
- Corncobs
- Cloth (rags, towels, blankets, etc.)
- Salmon
- Lilies
- Rubber (balls, rubber bands, etc.)

Our Donor-funded Community Programs

In addition to providing expert medical care, DoveLewis is committed to supporting the animal-loving community. Comfort, happiness, relief, peace of mind – these are just some of the benefits of DoveLewis' unique community programs. Our programs continue to grow and advance thanks to the generosity of our supporters and community members.

Velvet Assistance Fund

Every month DoveLewis awards \$19,000 to help eligible low-income families cover some of the costs for their pet's care. Last year we increased the fund by 67% thanks to the generosity of our donors.

Charlie Fund

The Charlie Fund ensures that abused animals receive the emergency care and compassion they desperately need and deserve.

Stray Animal & Wildlife Program

DoveLewis is committed to giving compassionate care to every stray animal brought through our doors. The Stray Animal & Wildlife Program helps offset the costs of caring for those animals.

Blood Bank Program

Animals need blood transfusions in emergencies, too! Nearly 150 canine and feline volunteers donate enough blood and plasma every year for more than 500 transfusions making ours the largest volunteer-based animal blood bank in the Pacific Northwest.

Portland Area Canine Therapy Teams (PACTT) Program

In partnership with Guide Dogs for the Blind, highly trained career-change dogs and their handlers complete DoveLewis' extensive training for certification in animal assisted therapy. In just this last years, 50 certified PACTT teams have logged over 5,400 volunteer hours in 70 facilities.

Pet Loss Support Program

We honor the human-animal bond and know that people are often expected to minimize their sorrow for a deceased pet. Recognizing the need for pet owners to talk and share stories about their lost pets, DoveLewis offers Portland's only Pet Loss Support Group free of charge.

What Kind of Events Could I Do?

We love how creative and inventive our supporters are, and appreciate all of your efforts. To help jumpstart some ideas, see below for some of our favorite event suggestions.

Community Fundraisers

Turning your love for Dove into a community fundraiser is as easy as hosting a car wash, party, BBQ or lemonade stand! Invite your family, friends, classmates and neighbors to participate. Hold the event every year to build momentum and create community!

Tournaments

Birthdays/Special Occasions

Workplace Campaigns

Toys & Treats for the Blood Bank Program

Our "superhero" blood donors get to pick out a toy of their very own after each donation, and each year we need to collect over 650 toys! New plush toys with a squeaker, durable tennis balls and bite-sized treats are preferable.



Hospital Supplies

Laundry never stops when you work in a 24/7 hospital, and fresh, clean laundry is essential to the health and happiness of our patients. For animal safety, supplies must be clean, with no major stains, holes or frayed edges. (Sorry, we are unable to accept pet beds at this time.)

- Towels (washcloths, hand towels, bath towels)
- Sheets (plain or fitted)
- Blankets

From newborn kittens to dogs with upset stomachs, baby food is an excellent, healthy solution to help our patients get well again. Please note that we only accept donations of **Beech Nut Brand Stage 1 Meat Flavors:**

- Beef and beef broth
- Chicken and chicken broth
- Turkey and turkey broth

Guidelines To Help You, The Organizer

Any fundraising activity that is coordinated and executed by community members and volunteers that benefits DoveLewis is called a "third-party fundraiser." The people executing the event are known as the "organizers."

Organizers Will:

- Be responsible for the operational/logistical planning of the activity or event, such as: securing date/venue, selling tickets/coordinating registration, contacting vendors, etc. DoveLewis will not be held liable for any costs associated with the fundraiser.
- Be responsible for all press releases, public service announcements, advertisements and printed materials (posters, brochures, flyers, tickets, invitations).
- Clearly state the portion of proceeds that benefit DoveLewis on all promotional materials.
- Ask approval for use of the DoveLewis logo and follow the DoveLewis logo guidelines:
 - o DoveLewis logo may not be incorporated into any other business logo.
 - o It cannot be used in conjunction with firearms or tobacco products.
- Comply with all federal, state and local regulation and cannot expose DoveLewis to any undue risk or liability.
- Cooperate fully with DoveLewis' cash management and gift acknowledgment procedures (see next page).

DoveLewis Will:

- Provide digital versions of the DoveLewis logos.
- Have right to decline association with any event or organization for any reason.
- Review and approve or decline all marketing materials in a timely manner.
- Loan banners and marketing materials (available for pick up).
- Promote approved events on social media and other digital outlets at least once.

Notes:

- For confidentiality reasons, DoveLewis cannot release donor or volunteer lists to the Organizer.
- Any raffles or drawings must be done in accordance to the law and do not fall under DoveLewis' raffle permit.

Insurance:

Insurance (if applicable) is the responsibility of the Organizer. Please provide proof of insurance to DoveLewis prior to the event. Organizers are responsible for any permits or licenses needed for the event.

Cash Management and Gift Acknowledgement Procedures

In accordance with IRS Regulations, Organizers must disclose to participants the amount or percentage of each payment that will benefit DoveLewis and any particular fund it may be designated towards.

At the conclusion of the event, the Organizer must reconcile the event revenue and submit the proceeds within 30 days of the event.

The Organizer will receive a written acknowledgement and tax receipt of the gift. Participants in the event will NOT receive an acknowledgement from DoveLewis and will not be eligible for a tax deduction.

If the event participants wish to make a donation to DoveLewis at the Organizer's event, the Organizer shall collect checks <u>payable directly to DoveLewis</u> and deliver checks to DoveLewis at the conclusion of the event. These donors will receive an acknowledgement letter from DoveLewis for their tax-deductible gift.
