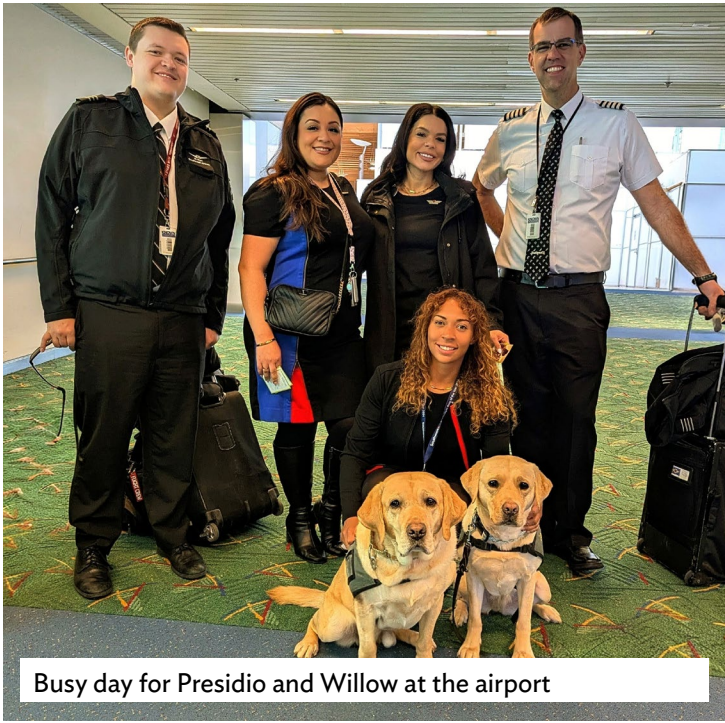

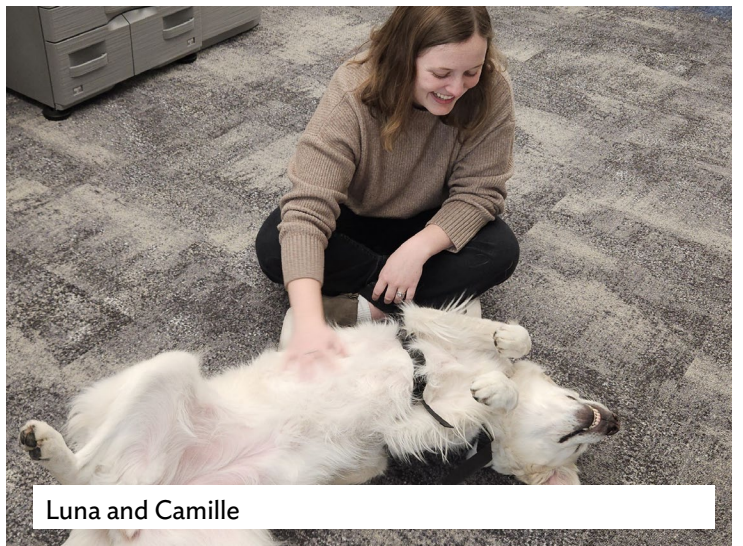

DOVELEWIS TAILS OF THE MONTH: Pain Management

Pain in our pets isn't always easy to see. Sometimes it's obvious—like limping or crying—but often it shows up in quieter ways: slowing down, hesitating to jump, or just not seeming quite like themselves. Chronic pain, such as arthritis, is a common part of aging, and even when the original cause is gone, discomfort can remain. While arthritis can't be reversed, thoughtful pain management can help pets stay comfortable and enjoy the life they love.

Caring for chronic pain is about more than just giving a pill. The most effective approach combines multiple therapies—medications, supplements, physical treatments, and small changes at home—all working together to support comfort and mobility.

At DoveLewis, our pain management service is centered on the individual pet and the bond they share with their family. During the first visit, we take time to listen, understand your concerns and goals, and create a personalized plan. This may include medications, supplements, acupuncture, laser

therapy, lifestyle adjustments, and nutrition support. Because every pet's needs change over time, we continue to adjust that plan through each stage of life.

Therapies like acupuncture and laser treatment can make a meaningful difference. Acupuncture helps increase circulation, ease muscle tension, and change how the brain processes pain. It can also support pets experiencing anxiety, cognitive changes, or nerve injury. Laser therapy uses gentle light energy to reduce inflammation, relieve pain, and support healing—all in a calm, comfortable setting.

We also work closely with other DoveLewis services, including surgery, neurology, and rehabilitation, to ensure each pet receives well-rounded care. Additional therapies like underwater treadmill exercise, massage, and guided movement can further improve strength, mobility, and confidence.

Pain management isn't just for older dogs with arthritis. We care for pets of all ages facing many kinds of pain—whether from injury, illness, cancer, or recovery from treatment. We see dogs, cats—and even the occasional rabbit—because every pet deserves comfort.



Real patients, real stories:

MARVIN, an especially handsome PACTT dog, had started to slow down from arthritis. With support, he's back to greeting the world with his usual enthusiasm.

LOKI, a cat with arthritis and a partial knee ligament tear, had stopped jumping and was struggling at home. Now, he's back to exploring high places—and helping himself to the occasional forbidden snack.

MARS, a German Shepherd with spinal bone cancer who resisted oral medications, found comfort through IV pain infusions—allowing for peaceful, quality time at home with his person.

ZIVA, a black cat with arthritic knees, was becoming more active and losing weight—until she suddenly gained some back. Her family soon discovered why: she felt well enough to sneak downstairs and help herself to extra food.

LOTTIE, a dachshund with severe neck pain that didn't respond to medication, had reached a heartbreaking point. After starting acupuncture and laser therapy, she felt so good she slipped her leash to chase someone down the block—joyfully returning to one of her favorite activities.

Pain may be a part of life, but it doesn't have to define it. Our goal is to ease discomfort and help pets continue to move, connect, and share meaningful moments with the people who love them—for as long as possible.
