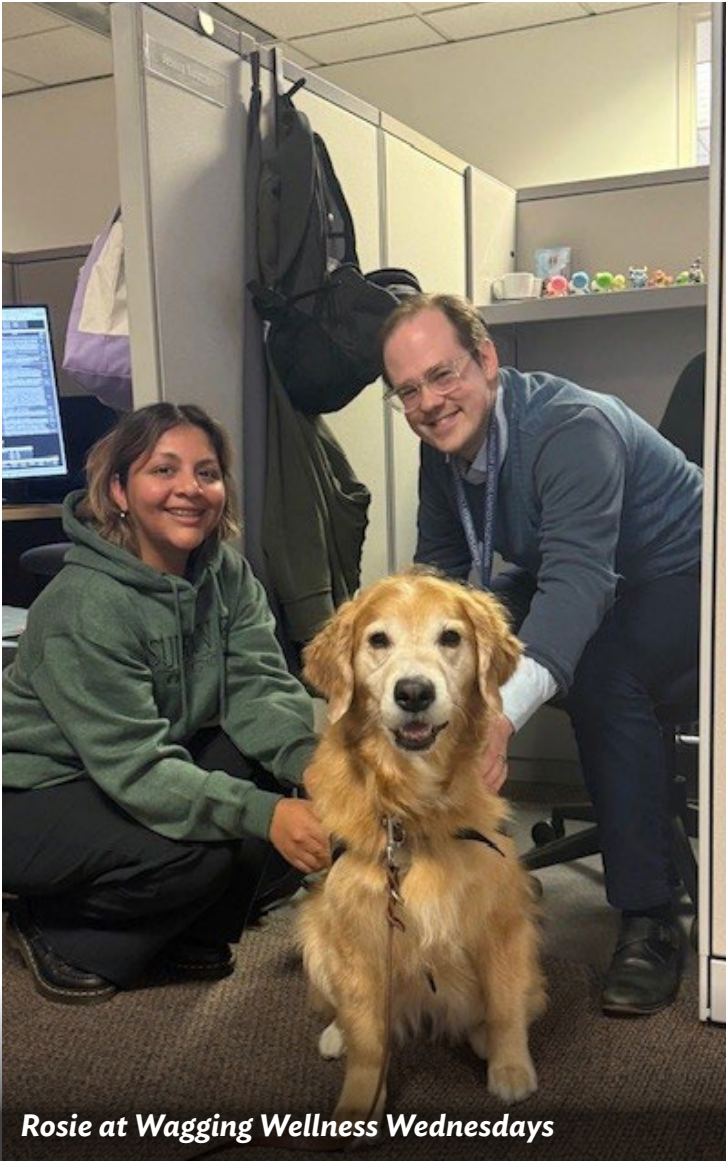

Additional Pet Loss Support Offerings

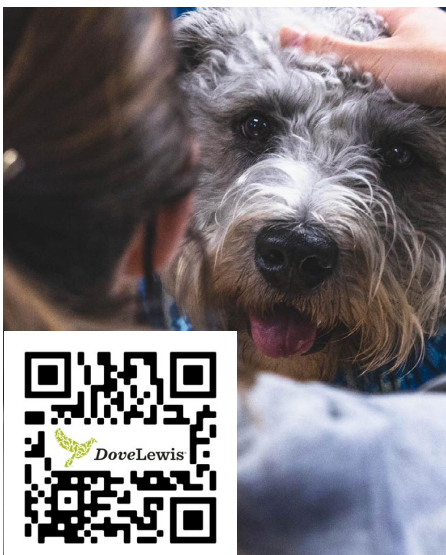

Virtual Memorial Writing Workshop: Sunday, December 14 from 3-5pm

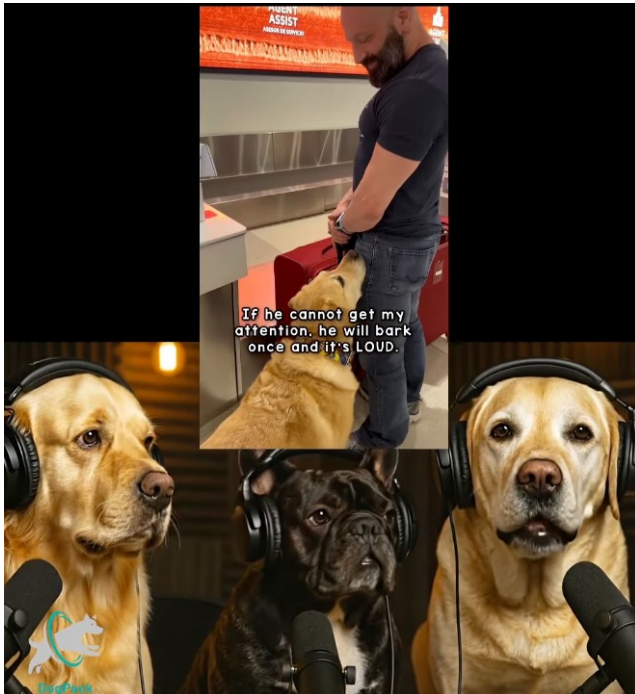
