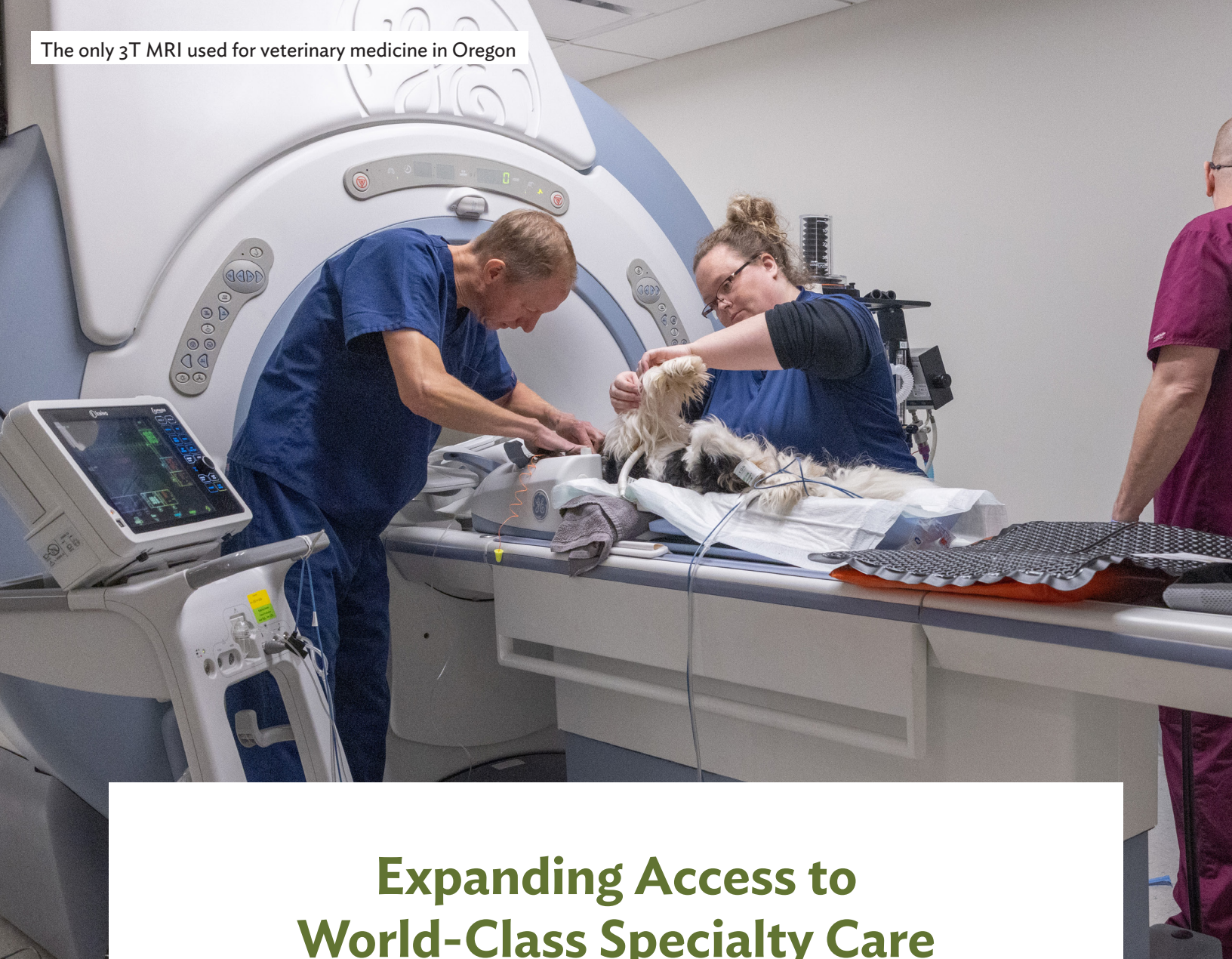
How the New Whiskers Specialty Hospital Impacts Pets & Families in the Pacific Northwest

What was once an ambitious vision is now transforming lives every day. Thanks to generous donor support, the addition of the Whiskers facility has expanded what's possible for animals and their families across the Pacific Northwest. This more than \$70 million investment has enabled DoveLewis to serve more patients, offer more specialties, and reduce barriers to care. Today, DoveLewis is one of the largest veterinary medical campuses in the United States outside academia.

Expanding Access to World-Class Specialty Care

Since opening Whiskers, DoveLewis has more than doubled specialty patient exams (up 102%). Internal medicine exams have increased 110%, and neurology exams 73%, giving significantly more pets access to advanced care. A new 3T MRI, the region's most advanced veterinary imaging technology, allows specialists to diagnose and treat complex cases in-house, reducing delays and improving outcomes. DoveLewis' new oncology and rehabilitation services are filling critical gaps in regional specialty care.

Together, these investments have expanded lifesaving care while creating a more seamless experience for families.

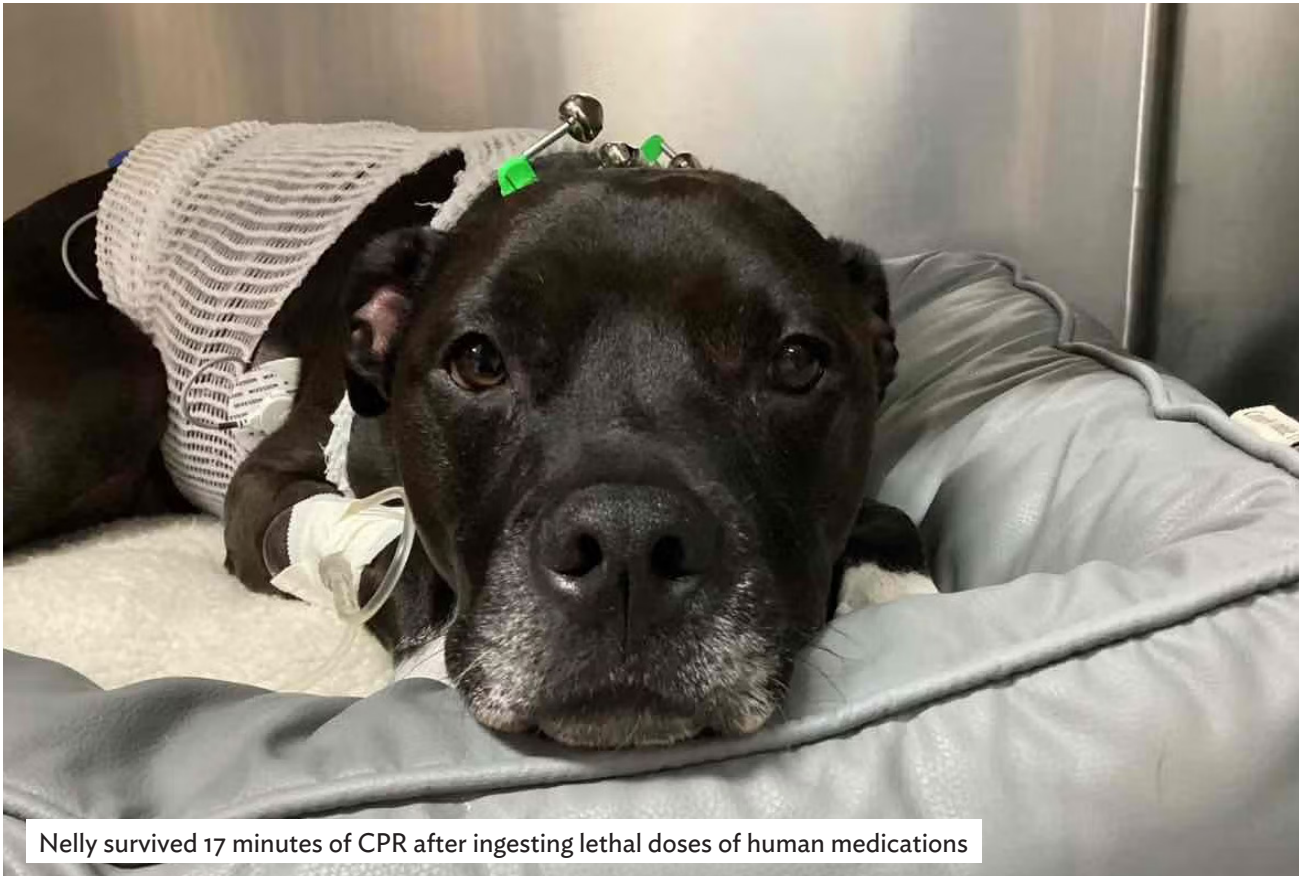


Strengthening Emergency Care

Relocating specialty services into Whiskers created much-needed capacity in the main hospital for emergency and critical care. Average triage times have been cut by more than 50%, emergency and ICU patient numbers have increased, and DoveLewis continues its work to meet growing community demand.
